Roberto Domínguez is Associate Professor in the Department of Government at Suffolk University. He holds a Ph. D. in International Studies from University of Miami and an M.A. from Ortega y Gasset Foundation, Spain as well as a Diploma on US Studies at the University of California in San Diego. He was professor of International Relations at UNAM, México as well as editor of the Journal *Relaciones Internacionales* (UNAM). Likewise, he has been visiting Professor at University of Quintana Roo (México) and Teikyo University (Maastricht, Netherlands) and currently is research associate at the European Union Centre of Excellence at University of Miami.

Dr. Dominguez's research interest is on security governance and regional integration. The following are some of his recent publications: *Security Governance and Regional Organizations* (with Emil Kirchner, Routledge, 2011); *European Union Foreign Policy* (New York: Edwing Mellen Press, 2008) and *Lisbon Fado: The European Union under Reform* (with Joaquin Roy, Miami European Union Center, 2009).

Dr. Domínguez was also columnist of the weekly magazine *Siempre* (1998-2000) He was political analyst at the Consulate of the United Kingdom in Miami (2005), political commentator for Radio Educación (1998-2001) and for *America en Vivo News* (Telemundo-NBC Network, 2004-2006). In the Mexican public service, he was advisor and speech writer for the Governor of the State of Mexico, head of the Department of Press Analysis at the Education Ministry, and head of the Department of International Press Analysis at the Foreign Affairs Ministry.
